



Summer Programme

- Modules to be read on a **graded** basis at the partner university (i.e. no "pass/fail" grade)
- Credit Transfers upon completion of course with at least a pass at the partner university
 - Only "OVS" grades will be awarded
 - "OVS" grade carries MCs but does not affect CAP
- **Module Mapping**
 - Breadth or Unrestricted Electives (depending on the content of modules read) with possibilities of Major and Faculty mapping
 - Modules read at the partner university **cannot have more than or equal to 50% overlap** with any modules that students have read or are intending to read at NUS

Summer Programme

- Maximum number of MCs that can be excluded from CAP Computation – <http://www.nus.edu.sg/registrar/edu/UG/graduation.html>
- Students who participate in up to two University-wide summer/winter programmes during their three/four years of study in NUS for up to a maximum of 12MCs credit transfer need not pay Special Tem fees

Eligibility

- UCLA/UOT/Mexico/UNSW – All Science **year 1, year 2 and year 3** undergraduate students (who are not graduating by the end of the semester of application) are welcome to apply. **Year 4** students (who are not graduating by the end of this semester) may also apply for **UNSW**.
- Male Singaporean students who have In-Camp-Training (ICT) during the period of the Summer Program, which coincides with the Special Terms at NUS, will not be granted deferment from their NS call-up. They will have to fulfill their NS liabilities.

Timeline & Interviews

- **07 - 14 Sep 2009: Apply** for UNSW Summer Programme online at Student intranet <https://neon.science.nus.edu.sg/intranet/student/>
- **16 & 17 Sep 2009:** For students who has applied, manual **sign up** for a suitable **interview time slot** at S16 L2 Dean's Office
- **23 (Wed) & 24 (Thu) Sep 2009 – Interviews**
- Students will be informed of the interview results via email, so please **check your NUS email regularly** from now onwards
- Students who are being selected for the programme must **confirm** their interest by **submitting ALL the relevant documents within 2 working days of offer**.
- Students are advised to **reserve their air tickets now** (do not make payment until place in Summer Programme is confirmed)

UNSW : Confirmation of Place & Submission of Relevant Documents

Please be prepared to submit **all** the following **within 2 days** of offer:

1. **Deposit**
 - A **cheque of \$1500** must be submitted to confirm your place in the summer programme (Deposit will be refundable upon successful completion of Summer Programme)
 - **Withdrawals:** Partial/No Refund will be made for cancellation by the student.
2. A copy of first page of **Passport**
3. A copy of first page of **Bank Book**
4. **Study Plan** for **all** modules that students intend to read.
5. Prepare Australia's **Visa and air ticket**

Financial Assistance

- **All module fees are funded by FoS.**
- **Faculty of Science will pay your summer programme course fees.** This subsidy is equivalent to ~\$3000 per student.
- We want our students to have a GLOBAL EDUCATION, and this is one way to make it more affordable.
- In part, this is made possible by **active alumni** of FoS. We hope to see more of you contributing back to the Faculty of Science.
- Students who fail/drop any modules during the summer programme have to pay for the modules fees

Additional Financial Assistance Sci@Unlimited™

- **Case-by-case Basis:** For needy students, we shall consider a **partial grant** or a **loan**, normally based on factors such as
 - **total family income** (substantiated by income tax statements or other equivalent documents) do not exceed **SGD\$24,000** every year.

- o Airfare (book yourself)

- o Accommodation (block booking through NUS)
 - o AUD40.57/night x 33nights = AUD1,338.81 ~ SGD1875
 - o Application Fee: AUD90 = SGD126
 - o Cleaning Fee: AUD100 = SGD140
- o Personal/Living Expenses:
 - o For meals, textbooks, public transit, and miscellaneous expenses (laundry, school supplies, recreation, etc.).
 - o AUD170/week x 5 wks = SGD1190
- o Health Insurance: Minimum AUD88 = SGD124
- o Travel Insurance: Yes and Encourage
- o Other expenses at UNSW (course materials, tours, etc.)
