Workload	At least 15 MCs & up to 26 MCs per semester. Students with CAP \geq 3.50 are allowed to do up to 32 MCs. (Only students in their graduating semester are allowed to read <15 MCs) Faculty Recommendation: 20 MCs per semester
Honours Project	At least an overall CAP of 3.50 on fulfillment of 100 MCs or more; and completed major requirements under the B.Sc./B.Appl.Sc. Programme
