If you are applying for both Sessions A & B, a Student Pass will be required (which we will provide further instructions), but otherwise if you are applying for only one session, you do not need a Student Pass (the social visitor/tourist pass lasts for 30 days).

Please note the fees for GSSP:

Registration fees: \$100 (incl. GST) - This is to be paid at the point of application.

Tuition fees and Miscellaneous fees (to be charged after you have been accepted into NUS):

2 units = \$1,382.80 (student from partner university) / \$1,728.50 (non-partner university)

4 units = \$2,765.60 (student from partner university) / \$3,457 (non-partner university)

Miscellaneous fees = \$73.65
