Location

This programme takes place in Guangzhou, China.

Dates

15 June 2026 to 31 July 2026

Course Mapping and Credit Transfer

Students may apply for course mapping and transfer a maximum of 10 units from one summer programme. Course mapping is subject to approval by the respective faculties/departments. 3 credits at HKUST(GZ) is equivalent to 4 NUS units.

Students can transfer a total of 12 units from a maximum of 2 overseas summer/winter programmes without having to pay tuition at NUS during their course of study. Any additional units mapped will be subjected to NUS Special Term fees.

HKUST courses may have pre-requisite(s). Fulfilment of pre-requisite(s) are reviewed and determined at the discretion of HKUST.

Course mapping and credit transfer for online summer programmes is not allowed.

Eligibility Criteria

NUS students must:

- Be a full-time Faculty of Science student with a first major in Science
- Year 1, 2 and 3 students may apply
- Not intending to graduate at the end of AY2025/2026 Semester 2
- Minimum GPA of 3.0
- Have a clean disciplinary record
- Be fully vaccinated
- National Servicemen who are not called up for In-Camp Training (ICT). Deferment letter will not be provided.

Number of places

There are 4 places available.

Accommodation

All students will be accommodated in on-campus university housing (shared living room and independent bedroom). For more information on housing facilities and residential life, please visit the <u>Student Dormitories website</u>.

Programme Cost

Students do not need to pay NUS Special Term fees or tuition fees to HKUST(GZ) if they do not exceed the credits transfer limit stated under the section "Credit Transfer" above. However, students are responsible for the programme fee (housing & insurance), their own airfare, meals, personal expenses, etc.

- A withdrawal penalty of \$300 will be charged if students withdraw after accepting the offer.
