Subject: Nudibranch, *Anteaeolidiella cacaotica* (Mollusca: Gastropoda: Nudibranchia: Aeolidiidae).

Subject identified by: Toh Chay Hoon.

Location, date and time: Johor Strait, Changi Point; 15 July 2022; 0448 hrs.

Habitat: Estuarine shore. Among coral rubble in intertidal zone, during morning low tide.

Observers: Teo Xue Shen and Ho Song Thye.

Observation: One example of about 2 mm total length, was found under a rock (Fig. 1).

Remarks: *Anteaeolidiella cacaotica* was first recorded from Singapore at Labrador shore in November 2020 (Choo, 2020). The present specimen appears to be the second local record, and at a different location in the northeast corner of Singapore Island.
